

Top 5 Covid-19 global key measures

Australia

The Federal Government has announced the JobKeeper payments scheme will be extended beyond September 2020.

The extended scheme will apply at a top rate of \$1,200 per JobKeeper fortnight until 3 January 2021, then dropping to \$1,000 until 28 March 2021.

Portugal

A support system for employment and social entrepreneurship (+ CO3SO Employment) was created, with an allocation of 90 million euros.

Peru

In view of the extension of the state of emergency from 1 July to 31 July 2020 in specific areas of Peru, the Tax Administration (SUNAT) has established that no penalties or fines will be imposed on taxpayers that are domiciled within such areas as from 26 June 2020.

United Kingdom


Businesses who will become involved in completing customs declarations, carrying out customs processes such as importing and exporting and/or helping other businesses with HMRC Extends Deadline for Customs Training Grants import and export processes can apply for grants now with HMRC, funding up to £2,250 per employee that undertakes the training.

Panama-Government postponed to 31 July 2020 the deadline for filing 2019 income tax returns for individuals and companies (previous deadline was 17 July 2020).

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
